Charges laid for over-limit fishing

Conservation officers conducting a two-day blitz on the opening weekend of bass season found many anglers were taking more than their limit of fish.

Officers checked 266 resident and five non-resident anglers for compliance with provincial and federal fish and game regulations during the blitz on June 27-28, focusing on the Maitland River in Goderich.

Forty-four fisheries-related violations were found and 23 charges were laid. Twenty-two of these violations were related to over limits of bass. The remaining violations were dealt with by warnings and by educating anglers about:

- Fishing without a licence
- Transporting fish unlawfully taken or possessed
- Transporting crayfish overland
- Making a false statement to a conservation officer.

In addition, four violations were found for non-fisheries related legislation, for which officers laid three charges. The violations were related to having liquor in an open container in a public place and having care or control of a motor vehicle with an open container of liquor.

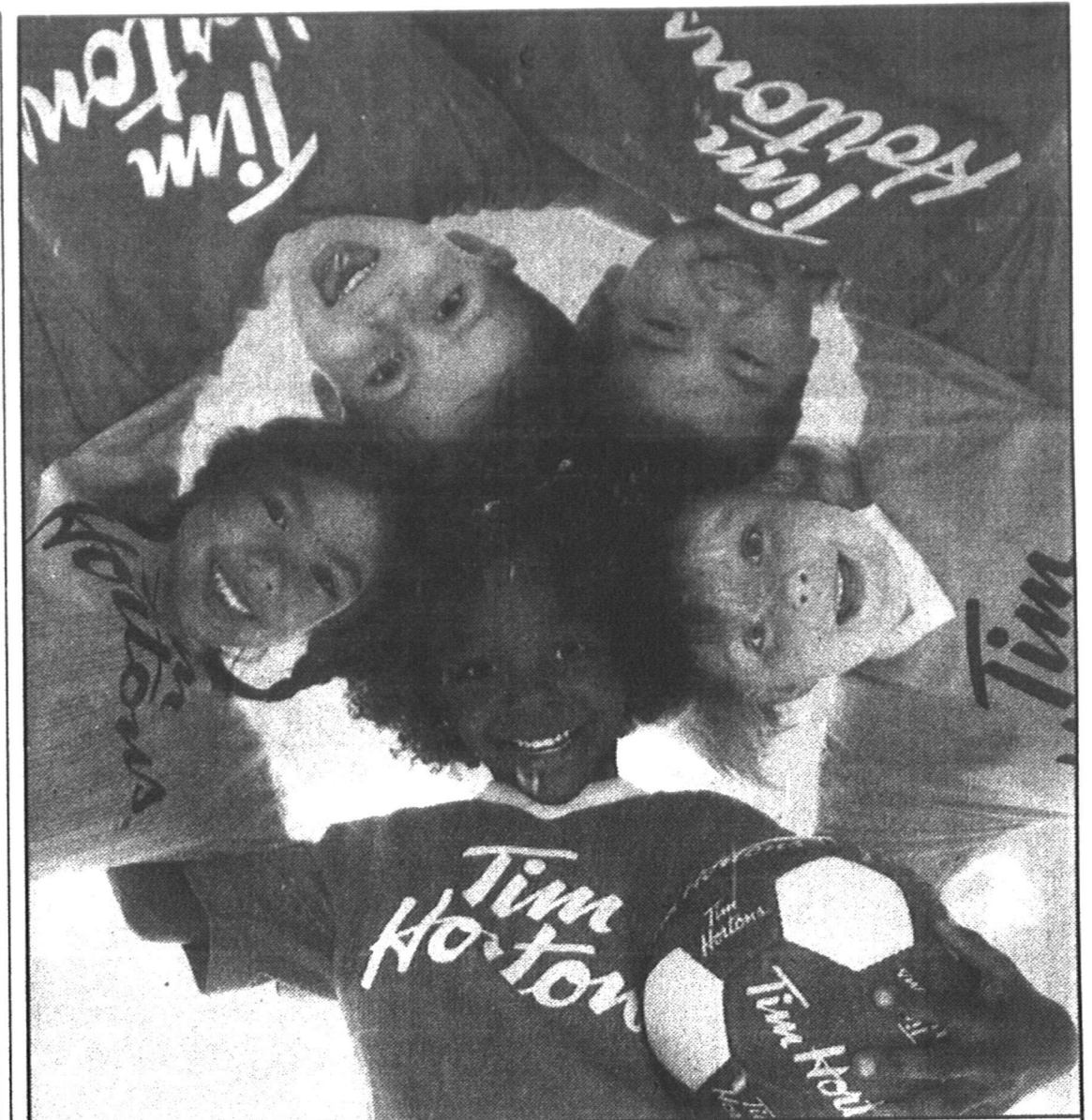

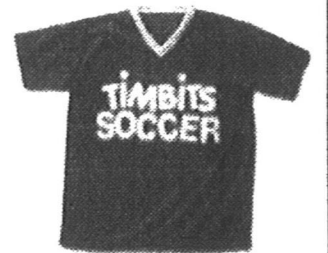

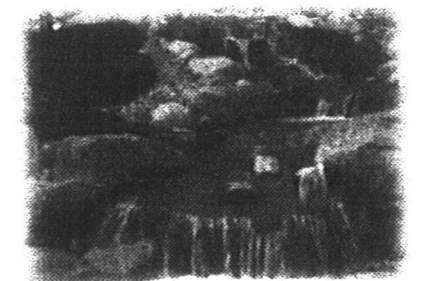
