

A ceremony marking the long-awaited opening of the Morris Tract will take place June 5 at the Benmiller United Church at 1:30 p.m., marking the end of a two-year campaign to save the tract, a natural heritage property. Trails in the 144-acre property have been closed to the public pending the opening which will see the attendance of members of the Nature Conservancy Of Canada, Ontario Parks, Ministry of Natural Resources and Friends of the Morris Tract, taking part. In 1995, Huron County had proposed allowing the Ministry of Natural Resources to log the property.
